COMPANY PROFILE



Mark Jansen van Rensburg is a passionate and driven qualified ILS Paramedic where he is registered and accredited with the HPCSA (Health Professional Council of South Africa) since 2003. He is the Managing Director of Medlink Africa (Pty) Ltd, a dynamic and fast-growing company specialising in various medical management events. Mark is also the Tactical ILS Paramedic who specializes in emergency medical care to traumatized victims during high-jackings, gender-based violence and domestic violence situations, working in conjunction with the SAPS Community Centre. Mark is also the Vice-Chairman of the board for the Kempton Park SPCA, where he often is called in to render medical consultations and give medical advice to the staff.

Mark has a 14-year history as an experienced Operational Sergeant-Major in the permanent force with the South African Defence Force specializing in military and intelligence operations. He also was appointed in the South African Police Services for 7 years. Mark continued to work throughout South Africa, as well as abroad into Africa, namely Sudan where he was deployed as a Paramedic for the United Nations Demining Services which included basic veterinarian skills (certified and accredited by Onderstepoort Veterinary Research Institute). On his return to South Africa in 2007, he went over to New Zealand where he completed his qualification in Dairy Management Level 4 which included animal healthcare. Again, returning to South Africa, he was then deployed to Dar-es-Salaam, Tanzania where he spent several months as the appointed project manager in the building of a full boutique hospital, comprising of an emergency trauma casualty unit with operating theatres, neo-natal ICU units and a well woman's clinic.

Mark co-founded a company called Paramedics for Hire (Pty) Ltd in 2011, with branches in Gauteng and Western Cape, where he was contracted in on a Brazilian Drilling Rig Ship based in Cape Town for a few months, as the onboard Medical Technician. The company was involved in various operations from schooling events to business corporate events and on the production crews for film and movie productions. When the COVID pandemic started and the world went into lockdown, the company was integral during this period to ensure that all business travellers based on various cargo and container ships underwent stringent PCR Swab testing and assisted in the alignment of the government's implementation of protocols for COVID were adhered to. After the pandemic and lifting of protocols he has subsequently left the company and returned to Johannesburg. He formed a new business entity namely Medlink Africa (Pty) Ltd, a professional company of highly motivated medical personnel, that offer personalised services and a dedication to delivering quality and compassionate medical service.

Medlink Africa (Pty) Ltd renders medical standby services at various corporate companies, sporting, and racetrack events, family fun days, mountaineering and water rescue services, as well as at many commercial and movie film productions, a recent series production was spent in Zanzibar for over 2 months for the filming of "Survivor India". They have also provided and deployed highly qualified medics on various school camps since 2013 up until now, which is a requirement from the education department. Current contracts for these camps are rendered for St John's College Wilderness Camp, Dainfern College, Redhill School, The Ridge School, St Andrews Girls, King David School, various Curro schools, and many others. Mark has been involved as the Paramedic and logistical administrator for the famously known DJ Rally (Durban to Johannesburg Classic Motorcycle Rally), where he has been on board with them as part of their family since 2013.
